Dear Mr Ozturk

REG DOMINGO

We've been approached for advice by Reg Domingo and Reg is very concerned about the imputations contained in your email to ACON of last Friday and then again on Monday of this week but also additionally, today. We do not act for ACON in this matter and ACON has not solicited our representation of Reg. Reg contacted us on Saturday and met with us on Sunday. Since that time he has given us further instructions.

We appreciate that you're fired up about your experience at Evo Media and the treatment of employees at the company since your employment ended there. We also appreciate your efforts to bring the company to account and to get them to pay their employee entitlements as they are legally obliged to do.

Your passion for ethics in the corporate world is admirable but we do not propose to comment any further on the conduct of Evo Media, suffice to say they should be held accountable as all corporations should.

In any event, we have advised Reg on his rights and we propose the dispute between you and he is resolved. It is our view that the issue between you and Reg should be settled swiftly and amicably because you two as a combined force will really be something to be reckoned with. You would be far more effective if you both stood together and called Evo Media to account. The real targets of your complaint are Dean Bell and Mark Anthony.

In order to bring about the combined force, we ask that you write an apology/retraction and withdraw the comments as far as they apply to Reg and also ask that you refrain from writing such emails or making statements against Reg. We ask this because your understanding of Reg's role at Evo Media is incorrect. Indeed, he was the Editorial Director/Managing Editor with editorial and creative responsibility for SX Magazine and online content on the Gay News Network and Same Same.

Reg was not responsible for company management, payment of salaries and superannuation, sales of advertising, printing and distribution of magazines and was not privy to Dean Bell's and Mark Anthony's discussions with their legal and financial advisors. Reg is owed substantial entitlements in his own right.

With respect to you and your endeavours, we ask that you apologise to Reg publicly by emailing the recipients of your previous email communication of Friday, Monday and today, and stating very clearly that:

- 1 you withdraw your representations (explicit and implied) that Reg:
 - (a) is a criminal;
 - (b) is not of good character;
 - (c) cannot be trusted;
 - (d) took part in criminal conduct;
 - (e) engaged in fraud;
 - (f) acted to prejudice employee entitlements at Evo Media;
 - (g) was in control of Evo Media; or
 - (h) contributed to the state of Evo Media.

- 2 you are sorry for the misrepresentations about Reg and you are working with Reg to resolve the broader issue that is the vast sum of employee entitlements owed by Evo Media to past and present employees, including Reg himself.

In moving towards a combined force, Reg has alerted the ATO to the superannuation issues and offer his assistance to any class action against Evo Media.

We believe this is the best way forward for both of you and also the best way forward in bringing the company to account.

We have been instructed by Reg to respond to your questions of ACON so far as they relate to Reg. A letter will follow.

We look forward to working together with you.
